Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) respectfully submits this letter to clarify the telemetry, tracking, and command (“TT&C”) frequencies for the above-referenced request for a grant of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)<sup>1</sup> to conduct in-orbit testing of Intelsat 19 at 176.0° E.L., and to drift the satellite to its permanent location of 166.0° E.L.<sup>2</sup>

The specific TT&C frequencies are as follows:
