The request of DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC (DIRECTV), for special temporary authority, IBFS File No. SAT-STA-20150105-00001, is GRANTED. Accordingly, DIRECTV is authorized, for a period of 30 days, to conduct Telemetry, Tracking, and Command (TT&C) operations necessary to drift the DIRECTV-14 space station (Call Sign S2869), along with the DIRECTV RB-1 payload (Call Sign S2711), from the 76° W.L. orbital location to the 99.235° W.L. orbital location using the following center frequencies: 28351.0 MHz (Earth-to-space), 28353.0 MHz (Earth-to-space), 18799.0 MHz (space-to-Earth), and 18799.5 MHz (space-to-Earth). Operations under this authorization must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant and with Federal Communication Commission's rules, and is subject to the following conditions:

1. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, *i.e.*, DIRECTV must not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, DIRECTV must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
3. DIRECTV must coordinate its TT&C operations with all other potentially affected operators and ensure that no harmful interference results.
4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at DIRECTV's own risk.
5. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC (“DIRECTV”) hereby requests Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for telemetry, tracking and control (“TT&C”) functions during the drift of the DIRECTV 14 satellite (call sign S2869) along with the DIRECTV RB-1 payload (call sign S2711) from 76° W.L. to the 99.235° W.L. orbital location at the conclusion of in-orbit testing (“IOT”). This STA will cover a period of approximately 30 days.

DIRECTV 14 is currently undergoing IOT at 76° W.L., and that process should be completed on or about January 12, 2015. DIRECTV requests an STA to cover TT&C while the satellite is relocated to its licensed orbital location at 99.235° W.L. During the period covered by this STA, DIRECTV will use 28351.0 and 28353.0 MHz for its command uplinks and 18799.0 and 18799.5 MHz for its telemetry downlinks. DIRECTV will coordinate with potentially affected satellite operators in accordance with industry practice, and will operate on a non-interference basis during this migration.

Grant of this STA request will serve the public interest by allowing DIRECTV to place the DIRECTV 14/RB-1 satellite at its licensed orbital location so that it can begin providing service to millions of DIRECTV subscribers. Accordingly, and in light of the impending completion of IOT, DIRECTV requests the expeditious grant of special temporary authority.
