Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein supplements its above referenced request for Special Temporary Authority (“STA”). Specifically, Intelsat again clarifies that it will operate Galaxy 11 in the 11700 – 12200 MHz band at 60.1° E.L against the United Kingdom’s INTELSAT KUEXT 60E filing, in conformance with relevant coordination agreements.¹ Intelsat respectfully requests that the United States Administration state its non-objection to the United Kingdom’s use of Galaxy 11 for purposes of maintaining the INTELSAT KUEXT 60E filing.
