On May 31, 2019, DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV") filed the above-captioned application requesting a grant of special temporary authority ("STA") for 60 days commencing June 17, 2019 to drift its T10 satellite (Call Sign S2641) from its current location at 102.85° W.L. to 102.75° W.L. and to operate the telemetry, tracking, and command and communications frequencies on the T10 satellite at 102.75° W.L. and during the drift from 102.85° W.L. to 102.75° W.L. DIRECTV files this supplemental letter to respectfully request that the Commission grant DIRECTV's STA request for a 30-day period rather than a 60-day period as originally requested in the application.<sup>1</sup>
