Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein supplements its above referenced request to update both the requested commencement date and launch date, and to clarify the in-orbit testing locations. Specifically, Intelsat updates the requested commencement date of its request to **August 23, 2019** and the launch date to **August 6, 2019**. Additionally, Intelsat clarifies that payload testing of 5850-6425 MHz, 13000-13250 MHz, and 13750-14000 MHz will occur at 55.3° E.L. All other information in the request remains unchanged.
