Intelsat License LLC, at the request of Federal Communications Commission staff, herein supplements its above-referenced request to update Intelsat 39's final location to 61.95° E.L. In a related Special Temporary Authority ("STA") grant, Intelsat was recently authorized to conduct inorbit testing of, and to operate Intelsat 39 at 61.95° E.L. As such, the first sentence of the above referenced application should now read:

Intelsat License LLC herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority previously granted to Intelsat to ... drift the satellite to **61.95**° **E.L.**
