Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat"), at the request of Federal Communications Commission staff, provides the following clarification with regards to the above-referenced request. Specifically, Intelsat tested the following bands at 55.3° E.L.: 3625-4200 MHz; 10700-10950 MHz; 11200-11450 MHz; 11450-11700 MHz; and 12250-12750 MHz (space-to-Earth); and 5850-6425 MHz; 13000-13250 MHz; 13750-14000 MHz; and 14250-14500 MHz (Earth-to-space); and will test 10950-11200 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 14000-14250 MHz (Earth-to-space) at 61.95° E.L.
