Pursuant to Condition 4 of the above-referenced grant of Special Temporary Authority,<sup>1</sup> DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV"), by its attorneys, provides further details regarding the additional ground station support and refinements to the Spaceway-1 de-orbit plan. DIRECTV will utilize four telemetry, tracking, and control earth stations during drift, including Intelsat License LLC's Riverside, California Ka-band earth station (call sign E170039) which will provide greater western visibility. DIRECTV will also target a de-orbit altitude for the spacecraft, up to 500 km above the geostationary arc, prior to decommissioning the satellite.
