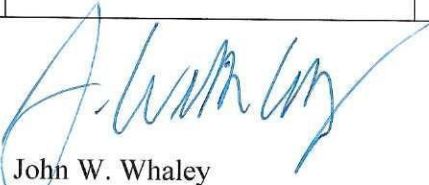
1. Operations pursuant to this special authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, *i.e.* the DIRECTV T8 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and DIRECTV must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating space station. In the event of any harmful interference, DIRECTV must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
2. DIRECTV must coordinate the operations of DIRECTV T8 with existing geostationary space stations to ensure that no unacceptable interference results from its operations.
3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of this special temporary authority is solely at DIRECTV's own risk.
4. During the drift from the 100.75° W.L. orbital location to the 119.05° W.L. orbital, DIRECTV must only operate the TT&C frequencies on DIRECTV T8.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.

This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Station licenses are subject to the conditions specified in Section 309(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as
