
1. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, *i.e.*, T10 must not cause harmful interference to, and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, DIRECTV must cease operations of T10 immediately upon notification of such interference and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
2. DIRECTV must coordinate the operations of T10 with existing geostationary space stations to ensure that no unacceptable interference results during the drift from the 102.75° W.L. orbital location to the 102.8° W.L. orbital location.
3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of this special temporary authority is solely at DIRECTV's own risk.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.

This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
