SES Americom, Inc. ("SES") pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules, hereby updates the record regarding the above-referenced applications seeking authority to relocate the AMC-18 C-band fixed-satellite space station from 139° W.L. to 83° W.L. (the "AMC-18 Applications"). Specifically, SES advises the Commission that the AMC-18 spacecraft will arrive at 83° W.L. on December 4, 2020.

On October 19, 2020, SES filed a letter notifying the Commission of a 10-day delay in the schedule to begin drifting the spacecraft in order to resolve customer issues.<sup>1</sup> SES began the drift on October 26, 2020.

SES respectfully requests that the Commission update its files regarding the AMC-18 Applications to reflect AMC-18's scheduled arrival at 83° W.L. on December 4, 2020. Please address any questions regarding this matter to Kelsie Rutherford at +1 202-478-7191 or kelsie.rutherford@ses.com.
