Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., the Intelsat 10 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Intelsat 10 must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
- 2. Intelsat must coordinate the operations of Intelsat 10 with existing geostationary space stations to ensure that no unacceptable interference results from its operations during drift to the 177.8° E.L. orbital location.
- 3. Intelsat must operate only the TT&C frequencies authorized for Intelsat 10 during the space station's drift to the 177.8° E.L. orbital location.
- 4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat's own risk.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned. This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> In its application, Intelsat also requested special temporary authority to operate Intelsat 10 at the 177.8° E.L. orbital location. However, because the drift is expected to last approximately twelve weeks, we dismiss Intelsat's request to operate Intelsat 10 at 177.8° E.L. since it will be outside the term of this 60-day STA grant. We note that Intelsat has a pending 180-day special temporary authority request to drift to, and operate Intelsat 10 at, the 177.8° E.L. orbital location (IBFS File No. SAT-STA-20210125-00014), and this dismissal-in-part is without prejudice to any decision on that application or future applications.
