Unless otherwise specified herein, operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with the Federal Communications Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., the Intelsat 10 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Intelsat 10 must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
- 2. Intelsat must coordinate the operations of Intelsat 10 with existing geostationary space stations to ensure that no unacceptable interference results from its operations during drift to the 177.8° E.L. orbital location.
- 3. Intelsat must operate only the TT&C frequencies authorized for Intelsat 10 during the space station's drift to the 177.8° E.L. orbital location.
- 4. In connection with the provision of service in any particular country, Intelsat is obliged to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, rules, and licensing procedures of that country.

- 5. For operations at the 177.8° E.L. orbital location, Intelsat must maintain the Intelsat 10 spacecraft with an east/west longitudinal station-keeping tolerance of +/- 0.05 degrees.
- 6. Intelsat must operate Intelsat 10 at the 177.8° E.L. orbital location in compliance with all existing or future coordination agreements for this location. In the absence of a coordination agreement, such communications must comply with applicable provisions of the ITU Radio Regulations as the Commission cannot guarantee the success of the required coordinations.
- 7. The operations of Intelsat 10 and associated earth stations must comport with the applicable uplink and downlink limits in 47 CFR § 25.140(a)(3) of the Commission's rules, unless Intelsat coordinates any non-conforming operations with the operations of U.S.-licensed geostationary orbit space stations within 6 degrees of the 177.8° E.L. orbital location. Intelsat must also comport with the maximum power limits indicated in existing or future coordination agreements at 177.8° E.L. Non-conforming operation must also be coordinated with respect to those operations of non-U.S.-licensed space stations within 6 degrees of 177.8° E.L. involving approved communications with U.S.-licensed earth stations.
- 8. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat's own risk.
- 9. Operations of Intelsat 10 at the 177.8° E.L orbital location must otherwise comply with the conditions imposed in the prior authorizations and applicable license modifications. *See*, *e.g.*, IBFS File Nos. SAT-MOD-20130322-00052, SAT-MOD-20160422-00038, and SAT-MOD-20191008-00109.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned. This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Station licenses are subject to the conditions specified in Section 309(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(h).
