Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., the Galaxy 14 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Galaxy 14 must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event. 2. Intelsat must continue to comply with the grant conditions set forth in IBFS File No. SAT-MOD-20051206-00261. 3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat’s own risk. 4. Any operations of Galaxy 14 in the 3700-4200 MHz band, within the contiguous United States, are subject to the terms of the <i>3.7-4.2 GHz Report and Order</i>, 35 FCC Rcd 2343 (2020), including Section 2.106, footnote NG182 and footnote NG457A, future actions in the proceeding, and actions on delegated authority taken in accordance with the Commission’s Order (<i>see, e.g.,</i> Public Notice DA 20-578, released June 1, 2020, announcing accelerated clearing in the 3.7 – 4.2 GHz band).		

¹ Intelsat previously received authority to drift, maintain, and operate Galaxy 14 at the 32.9° E.L. orbital location. *See* IBFS File No. SAT-STA-20210106-00003. In addition, on February 8, 2021, Intelsat notified the Commission of the commencement of inclined orbit operations for Galaxy 14. *See* Letter from Cynthia J.
