Unless otherwise specified herein, operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with the Federal Communications Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., the Galaxy 25 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Galaxy 25 must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
- 2. Intelsat must coordinate the operations of Galaxy 25 with existing geostationary space stations to ensure that no unacceptable interference results from its operations during drift to the 66.13° E.L. orbital location.
- 3. Intelsat must operate only the TT&C frequencies authorized for Galaxy 25 during the space station's drift to the 66.13° E.L. orbital location.
- 4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat's own risk.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned. This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261,

¹ We previously granted special temporary authority to Intelsat to drift Galaxy 25 to the 66.13° E.L. orbital location. *See* IBFS File Nos. SAT-STA-20210917-00124 (granted in part, dismissed in part, Sept. 30, 2021); SAT-STA-20210727-00092 (granted in part, dismissed in part, Aug. 19, 2021).

² In its application, Intelsat also requested special temporary authority to operate Galaxy 25 at the 66.13° E.L. orbital location. However, because Intelsat states that the drift is expected to last approximately five weeks, we dismiss Intelsat's request to operate Galaxy 25 at 66.13° E.L. since such operations would be outside the term of this 30-day STA grant. We note that this dismissal-in-part is without prejudice to any decision on future applications.
