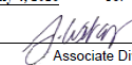

Unless otherwise specified herein, operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with the Federal Communications Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions: 1. Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., the Galaxy 34 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Galaxy 34 must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.

Due to a lapse in funding, the Commission extended the deadline to December 5, 2025 for any grants of special temporary authority expiring between October 1, 2025 and December 5, 2025. 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2. In connection with the provision of service in any particular country, Intelsat is obliged to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, rules, and licensing procedures of that country.
3. The operations of Galaxy 34 in the 3700-4200 MHz band, within the contiguous United States, are subject to the terms of the 3.7-4.2 GHz Report and Order, 35 FCC Rcd 2343 (2020), including Section 2.106, footnote NG182 and footnote NG457A, future actions in the proceeding, and actions on delegated authority taken in accordance with the Commission's Order (*see, e.g.*, Public Notice DA 20-578, released June 1, 2020, announcing accelerated clearing in the 3.7 – 4.2 GHz band).
4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat's own risk.
5. All other operations of Galaxy 34 at the 129.0° W.L. orbital location must be in accordance with the most recent modification of the authorization for the Galaxy 34 space station, ICFS File No. SAT-RPL-20210325-00039.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.

This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Station licenses are subject to the conditions specified in Section 309(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(h).
