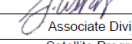

Unless otherwise specified herein, operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with the Federal Communications Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions: 1. Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., the Galaxy 28 space station must not cause harmful interference to, and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Galaxy 28 must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event. 2. Intelsat must operate Galaxy 28 at the 27.1° W.L. orbital location in compliance with all existing or future coordination agreements for this location. In the absence of a coordination agreement, such communications must comply with applicable provisions of the ITU Radio Regulations as the Commission cannot guarantee the success of the required coordinations. 3. The operations of Galaxy 28 in the 3700-4200 MHz band, within the contiguous United States, are subject to the terms of the 3.7-4.2 GHz Report and Order, 35 FCC Rcd 2343 (2020), including section 2.106, footnote NG182 and footnote NG457A, future actions in the proceeding, and actions on delegated authority taken in accordance with the Commission's Order (<i>See, e.g.,</i> Public Notice DA 20-578, released June 1, 2020, announcing accelerated clearing in the 3.7 – 4.2 GHz band). 4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority
