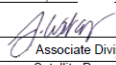

Unless otherwise specified herein, operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with the Federal Communications Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions:

1. Operations pursuant to this special temporary authority must be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, i.e., they must not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating station. In the event of any harmful interference, Intelsat must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and shall inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
2. In connection with the provision of service in any particular country, Intelsat is obliged to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, rules, and licensing procedures of that country.
3. SES' request for waiver of 47 CFR § 25.210(j) to allow SES-2 to operate with an east/west station-keeping tolerance of ± 0.1 degrees, IS GRANTED. Section 25.210(j) states that space stations "must be maintained within 0.05 degrees of their assigned orbital longitude in the east/west direction, unless specifically authorized by the Commission to operate with a different longitudinal tolerance." SES states that operating SES-2 at a ± 0.1 degree east/west station-keeping tolerance would conserve fuel because the need for eccentricity maneuvers would be significantly reduced, and that such operation would not adversely affect the operation of other satellites. The closest satellites to SES-2 are Tupac Katari 1, and FM-5, 0.2 degrees and 0.85 degrees away, respectively, so SES-2's ± 0.1 degree east/west station-keeping volume will not overlap with that of other satellites. This waiver is limited to SES-2's operations at the 87.0° W.L. orbital location.
4. All other operations of SES-2 at the 87.0° W.L. orbital location must be in accordance with the most recent authorization for the SES-2 space station, ICFS File No. SAT-RPL-20110429-00082.

¹ SES seeks limited flexibility to repoint the KRH, KRV, KTH and KTV beams on file with the FCC within the envelope defined by the redline in the coverage map provided in Attachment A. Attachment A provides a composite isoline of the 8 dB below peak contour of all prospective pointings of the beams. Narrative at 1.

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5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this grant of special temporary authority is solely at SES' own risk.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.

This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Station licenses are subject to the conditions specified in Section 309(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(h).
