VisionStar Inc. and EchoStar VisionStar Corp., Application for Review, File No. SAT-RE: T/C-20001215-00163; FOIA Request No. 21-220.

Dear Mr. Michalopoulos:

This letter is in reference to the Application for Review filed by Echostar VisionStar Corporation (VisionStar) of the decision of the International Bureau to deny confidential treatment of certain information provided to the Commission as part of the transfer of control of VisionStar to EchoStar Satellite Corp. (EchoStar). Due to subsequent events - including the access provided to the information by means of a protective order,³ Pegasus Development Corp.'s communication indicating that it 'does not have an outstanding FOIA request' in this matter,4 and the conclusion of the underlying transfer of control proceeding for which the information was sought⁵ – we find that it is no longer necessary to rule on the Application for Review. Accordingly, we dismiss the Application for Review as moot. Since there is no longer a request to access the information, we will not at this time make public the information not already released by VisionStar and EchoStar, but will treat it in the same manner as all information for which confidentiality is requested pursuant to the Commission's regulations, 47 C.F.R. § 0.459.
