RESPONSE TO REQUEST

In response to a request for additional information from the International Bureau regarding the applications for the transfer of control of the non-common carrier satellite licenses of Constellation Communications Holdings, Inc. (File No. SAT-T/C-20020718-00114) and Mobile Communications Holdings, Inc. (File No. SAT-T/C-20020719-00104), ICO Global Communications (Holdings) Limited (“ICO”), the proposed transferee, submits the following information:

1. Eagle River Investments, LLC (“Eagle River”), a U.S. entity, holds 69.7 percent of the voting interests and 34.45 percent of the economic interests in ICO. Craig O. McCaw, a U.S. citizen, holds a controlling interest in Eagle River. No foreign entities hold voting or economic interests in Eagle River.

2. Cascade Investment, L.L.C. (“Cascade”), a U.S. entity, holds 13.4 percent of the voting interests and 4.81 percent of the economic interests in ICO. William H. Gates III, a U.S. citizen, holds a controlling interest in Cascade. No foreign entities hold voting or economic interests in Cascade.
