Dear Ms. Dortch:

In response to an informal inquiry from International Bureau ("Bureau") staff regarding the above-referenced applications, ICO Global Communications (Holdings) Limited ("ICO") hereby provides additional information regarding the number of issued and outstanding shares of its stock.¹

As of November 4, 2002, the following shares of ICO stock were issued and outstanding: 139,107,102 shares of Class A common stock and 55,846,500 shares of Class B common stock. Furthermore, as of November 4, 2002, ICO Global Limited ("IGL"), a Delaware corporation and wholly owned subsidiary of ICO, held the following additional shares of ICO stock: 139,107,102 shares of Class A common stock and 31,003,382 shares of Class B common stock. Because IGL is a wholly owned subsidiary of ICO, shares of ICO held by IGL are non-voting stock under Delaware law and effectively are treated as shares of treasury stock.

¹ As previously requested by the Bureau, ICO, on October 15, 2002, submitted a copy of its Certificate of Incorporation describing the rights associated with each class of its stock.
