**Re: Request for Extension of *Pro Forma* Transfer of Control Deadline; File Nos. SAT-T/C-20060324-00027; SAT-T/C-20060324-00028; SES-T/C-20060327-00519; SES-T/C-20060327-00520; SES-T/C-20060327-00521; SES-T/C-20060327-00522; SES-T/C-20060327-00523**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat Holdings, Ltd. ("Intelsat"), by its attorneys, respectfully requests an additional 60 days to complete the *pro forma* transfer of control of the earth and space station licenses listed in the above-referenced applications. Effective April 18, 2006, the International Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission granted the above-referenced earth station applications,<sup>1</sup> and effective April 27, 2006, the International Bureau granted the above-referenced space station applications.<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to Section 25.119 of the Commission's rules, the deadline for consummating these transactions is 60 days after authorization.<sup>3</sup>

As explained in the above-referenced applications, the approved *pro forma* transfer of control will occur after Intelsat (Bermuda), Ltd. assigns all of its assets to a newly created, wholly-owned subsidiary, Intelsat Intermediate Holding Company, Ltd. The assignment of assets to Intelsat Intermediate Holding Company, Ltd. is part of the proposed financing of the anticipated merger of PanAmSat Holding Corporation and Intelsat. That transaction cannot close until the Commission approves the pending applications for transfer of control of PanAmSat's licenses to Intelsat in IB Docket No. 05-290.<sup>4</sup>


