Dear Mr. Blayber,

Please find attached Hughes Network Systems 1td. (HNS UK) application for a licence under the United Kingdom's Outer Space Act regarding the satellite identified as SPACEWAY 3 (SW3). The satellite was launched on 14 August 2007 from the Gulana Space Center and is presently in operation, carrying commercial traffic from the 94.95° West Longitude (WL) position in the geostationary arc. The satellite is currently registered as a US space object under the Convention on the Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space (Registration Convention).

HNS UK (with Hughes Network Systems, LLC (HNS LLC)) seeks through this licence application to transfer responsibility for this satellite under the Registration Convention from the United States of America to the United Kingdom, while continuing the current operation at 94.95 ° WL. A separate request for the transfer of SW3 from the USA to the United Kingdom has also been filed with the UK's Office of Communication (Ofcom) and the United States' Federal Communication Commission (FCC).
