Dear Sir or Madam:

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), on behalf of the Department of Justice and the Department of Defense (collectively, “the Agencies”) requests that the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) defer action on the above-referenced application and remove this application from streamlined processing. On November 1, 2017, the Department of Justice, on behalf of the Agencies, requested that the Commission defer action on the underlying Submarine Cable Landing license application (SCL-LIC-20170421-00012) in order for the Agencies to review this matter for national security, law enforcement, and public safety issues. The Agencies require additional time in order to complete such review. The Agencies therefore request that the Commission defer action until such time as the Agencies notify the Commission of the completion of their reviews and, based on the results of such review, request appropriate action by the Commission.

The Agencies will advise the Commission promptly upon completion of their review.
