BCE Nexxia Corporation (“BCE Nexxia”) and Marine Cable Corporation (“Marine Cable,” and, together with BCE Nexxia, the “Applicants”), by their attorneys,¹ hereby submit this letter to clarify and, to the extent necessary, amend the above-referenced Application, filed January 31, 2007.

Applicants certified in their Application that they are affiliated with foreign carriers in Canada and that Canada is a member of the World Trade Organization. *See* Application at 5-6. The Application therefore is eligible for streamlined treatment pursuant to the terms of section 1.767(k)(3) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(k)(3).
