**Re: Notification of *Pro Forma* Assignment; Cable Landing License SCL-LIC-19990823-00015 (South American Crossing Cable, or SAC)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and Section 1.767(g)(7) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(g)(7), GT Landing II Corp. (“GT Landing II”) and Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc. (“GCTI”) hereby notify the Commission of the *pro forma* assignment of the above-referenced submarine cable landing license from GCTI to GT Landing II.<sup>1</sup> This assignment occurred on April 14, 2010.


Both GT Landing II and GCTI are wholly-owned subsidiaries of Global Crossing North America, Inc., which in turn is an indirect subsidiary of Temasek Holdings (Private) Limited (“Temasek”). Thus, Temasek continues to have ultimate control of the entity holding this license. Accordingly, and as certified in the attached declaration pursuant to Section 1.767(g)(7), the assignment was *pro forma* as defined by the Commission’s rules. See 47 C.F.R. § 63.24(d) (“Transfers of control or assignments that do not result in a change in the actual controlling party are considered non-substantial or *pro forma*.”).

<sup>1</sup> In 2002, the Commission approved an application to modify the above-referenced license to include the *pro forma* condition in 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(g)(7). This license was previously assigned to GCTI, on a *pro forma* basis, by Global Crossing Latin America & Caribbean Co. See Public Notice, *Actions Taken Under Cable Landing License Act*, DA No. 09-2174, Report No. SCL-00093, at 2 (rel. Oct. 7, 2009).


