**SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION TO ASSIGN SPRINT'S
INTEREST IN THE AMERICAS I CABLE SYSTEM TO ATOC**

Atlantic Teleconnection Operating Company Limited (“ATOC”), pursuant to the Act Relating to the Landing and Operation of Submarine Cables in the United States, 47 U.S.C. §§ 34-39 (the “Cable Landing License Act”), Executive Order 10530, and Section 1.767 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.767, submits this supplement (“Supplement”) to the application filed February 22, 2019 requesting approval to assign the 6.95388 percent interest Sprint Communications Company L.P. holds in the Americas I Cable System to ATOC (“Application”). ATOC files this Supplement in response to an inquiry from the International Bureau in connection with the disclosures required by Section 63.18(h) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.18(h).

The table set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto lists all individuals and entities that will hold a ten percent or greater direct or indirect equity or voting interest in ATOC following consummation of the transaction. No other individual or entity will hold such an interest

following consummation. The table in Exhibit A replaces the table set forth on page 4 of the Application. Please note that Blackrock, Inc. (“Blackrock”) has been added to the table. Although Blackrock will not hold a ten percent or greater indirect interest in ATOC if the multiplier is used to calculate Blackrock’s interest, use of the multiplier is inappropriate in this instance pursuant to the Note to Section 63.18(h) of the FCC’s rules because ATNI’s interest in ATOC is above 50 percent and is controlling and Blackrock holds a direct interest in ATNI.



(“DTIT”) and that DTIT is indirectly controlled, but not wholly owned, by China Academy of Telecommunications Technology. ATOC does not have any additional information about HKGT’s ultimate ownership.

** ATNI is a publicly traded company listed on the NASDAQ (Ticker: ATNI). As of the date of this filing, no individual or entity, has reported to the Securities and Exchange Commission that it holds a direct or indirect 10 percent or greater equity or voting interest in ATNI, other than the individual and the entity listed in the table above.
