The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (“DHS”), with the concurrence of the U.S. Department of Justice and the U.S. Department of Defense (collectively, “the Agencies”), requests that the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) defer action on the above-referenced application and remove this application from streamlined processing. The Agencies are reviewing this matter for national security, law enforcement, and public safety issues and require additional time in order to complete such review. The Agencies intend to correspond with the Applicant and any relevant counsel in order to obtain information necessary in order to conduct such review. The Agencies therefore request that the Commission defer action until such time as the Agencies notify the Commission of the completion of their review and, based on the results of such review, request appropriate action by the Commission.

The Agencies will advise the Commission promptly upon completion of our review.
