**SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION FOR *PRO FORMA*
ASSIGNMENT OF CABLE LANDING LICENSE**

MCI Communications Corporation (“MCI”) and Verizon Business Global LLC (“Verizon Business”) hereby supplement their Application for Commission consent to the *pro forma* assignment of MCI’s interest in the MAYA-1 submarine cable (SCL-LIC-19990325-00006, SCL-MOD-20110928-00028) to Verizon Business in connection with an internal restructuring involving certain direct and indirect subsidiaries of Verizon Communications Inc. (“Verizon”). At the request of Commission staff, the parties provide the following information:

1. Footnote 1 of the Application is revised as follows:

“MCI also holds an interest in the Japan-US cable system, which qualifies for the Commission’s post-closing notification procedures. *See Actions Taken Under Cable Landing License Act*, Public Notice, DA No. 08-306, File No. SCL-MOD-20071130-00020, (Feb. 7, 2008) (adding the *pro forma* condition in 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(g)(7) to the Japan-US cable system); *see also Review of Commission Consideration of Applications Under Cable Landing License Act*, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 16 FCC Rcd 22167, 22199, ¶ 61 (2001) (“*SCL Order*”). Verizon Business will file a post-closing notification for the *pro forma* assignment of this submarine cable license

in compliance with Section 1.767(g)(7) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(g)(7).”

2. The address and telephone number for both the assignor and the assignee is: 1300 I Street, N.W., Suite 500 East, Washington, D.C., 20005, 202-515-2462.
3. Page 3 of the Application explains that as part of the internal reorganization, Bell Atlantic Mobile Systems LLC (“Old BAMS”) will change its name to BAMS Communications LLC (“BAMS Communications”). BAMS Communications will form a new wholly-owned subsidiary named Bell Atlantic Mobile Systems LLC (“New BAMS”), then contribute its assets to New BAMS. (In effect, New BAMS will take the place of Old BAMS in Verizon’s ownership structure.) Updated pre- and post-closing ownership charts are attached reflecting the name change of Old BAMS to BAMS Communications. The parties also clarify that Old BAMS currently holds (and New BAMS post-closing will hold) an approximate 23.64 percent interest in Cellco Partnership.
