**AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR *PRO FORMA*
ASSIGNMENT OF CABLE LANDING LICENSES**

MCI International, Inc. (“MCII”) hereby amends its Application for Commission consent to the *pro forma* assignment of its interests in several submarine cable licenses in connection with an internal restructuring involving certain direct and indirect subsidiaries of Verizon Communications Inc. (“Verizon”). As explained in the Application, the restructuring is scheduled to occur on or about June 30, 2020 and will include the conversion of MCII from a corporation to a limited liability company. The reorganization will therefore result in the *pro forma* assignment of its interests in multiple submarine cable licenses to MCI International, LLC (“MCII LLC”).

MCII amends the Application to reflect that it holds an approximate 4.178 percent interest in the Antillas I Cable System. In addition, the Application is amended to include the *pro forma* assignment of its interests in the Americas I Cable System (SCL-LIC-19921110-

00002), in which MCII holds a 17.39646 percent voting and equity interest, from MCII to MCII LLC.¹ As further explained in the Application, the internal restructuring will not change the ultimate control of any license or licensee and is presumptively in the public interest.
