Tata Communications (America), Inc. (“Tata Communications”), through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 63.19 of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.19, hereby notifies the Commission of Tata Communication’s intent to discontinue international services via the CANUS-1 subsea cable system. In support, Tata Communications submits the following information:

**3. Brief description of the type of service affected**

Tata Communications proposes to discontinue the provision of services using the CANUS-1 subsea cable system in anticipation of its decommissioning of the CANUS-1 system.

**4. Brief description of the dates and methods of notice to all affected customers**

Written notice has been sent to all customers holding rights to capacity over the CANUS-1 subsea cable system. Attached as Exhibit A is a copy of the customer notice letter. (The attached customer notice letter also references the CANTAT-3 undersea cable system. That system is not a U.S. jurisdictional cable.)

**II. Circumstances of Discontinuance**

Tata Communications has determined to decommission the CANUS-1 system before the end of this calendar year. To facilitate the decommissioning, service over that system will be discontinued on or about September 30, 2010, but no earlier than September 30, 2010. The discontinuance of services over the CANUS-1 system will not adversely affect the public convenience and necessity. The public will not be unduly harmed by discontinuance of the service described above because customers have been given notice that affords them an ample opportunity to work with Tata Communications to use alternative Tata Communications facilities or transfer to a new carrier.


**III. Conclusion**


