Re: Request for Correction in IBFS Database
FLAG Pacific Limited
IBFS File No. SCL-LIC-20000606-0023

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of FLAG Pacific Limited ("FLAG"), we request by this letter that the International Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC" or "Commission") correct an apparent error in its IBFS database. The IBFS database currently lists FLAG as the licensee of submarine cable landing license SCL-LIC-20000606-00023 ("License"), which authorizes FLAG to operate a submarine cable landing station for a transpacific cable. However, FLAG did not construct the submarine cable and has no intention to do so in the future. Consequently, FLAG does not operate such a cable landing station. In addition, on August 10, 2005, we received confirmation from Cathy Hsu of the International Bureau that the License previously was cancelled by the Commission because the proposed Pacific cable system was never built. Accordingly, we respectfully request that the FCC update the IBFS database to reflect the cancelled status of the License.
