Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of Global Caribbean Network ("GCN") and pursuant to recent correspondence between the undersigned counsel and Angela DeMahy of the Commission's International Bureau, the purpose of this letter is to confirm to the Commission that on September 15, 2006 the fiber-optic cable submarine cable system of GCN, authorized pursuant to a submarine cable license granted by the Commission on September 13, 2005, went into service.

As the Commission is aware, pursuant to the Commission's rules the ownership of GCN has changed since GCN's original submarine cable landing license was granted.¹ The original ownership and management of GCN is no longer associated with the Company, and, after an exhaustive search, the current management has not been able to locate the original letter (or a copy thereof) notifying the Commission when the GCN submarine cable system went into service. Accordingly, pursuant to Ms. DeMahy's July 19, 2018 email to the undersigned, GCN hereby submits this letter in lieu of its original in-service letter.

The current management of GCN has estimated the in-service date of the GCN submarine cable system by reference to industry web site references GCN believes to be reliable.²

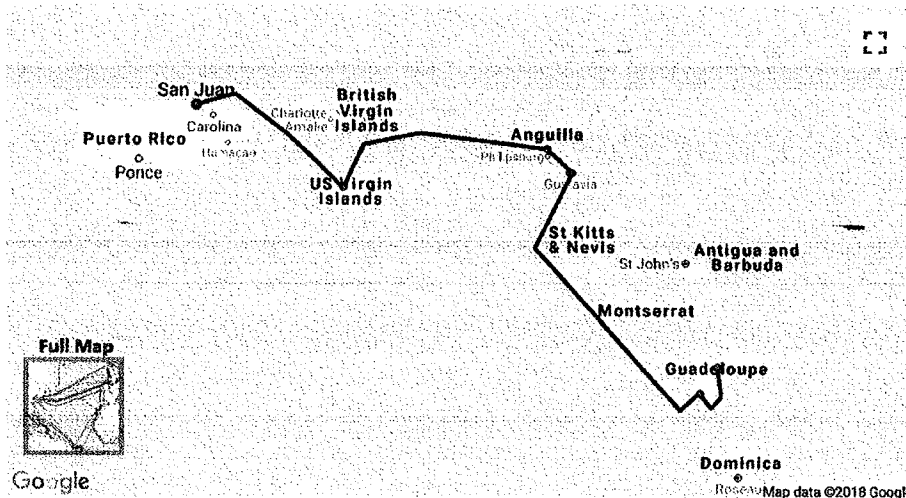
