On behalf of Columbus Networks USA, Inc. ("CNUSA"), licensee of the CFX-1 Cable System (SCL-LIC-20070516-00008), this responds to the request of Ms. Angela DeMahy of the International Bureau ("Bureau") staff for a copy of the original in-service letter for the CFX-1 Cable System.

CNUSA has reviewed its records carefully and cannot locate the original in-service letter for the CFX-1 Cable System. However, CNUSA's files contain the Phase I Certificate of Final Acceptance for the CFX-1 Cable System ("Phase I Certificate," copy attached as Exhibit 1) and the Phase II Certificate of Final Acceptance ("Phase II Certificate," copy attached as Exhibit 2). The Phase I Certificate states that Phase I of the CFX-1 Project was deemed Ready for Final Acceptance as of 11:59 PM Eastern Daylight Time on August 6, 2008; and the Phase II Certificate states that Phase II of the CFX-1 Project was deemed Ready for Final Acceptance as of 11:59 PM Eastern Daylight Time on September 17, 2008. Thus, September 18, 2008 appears to be the date that a segment of the CFX-1 Cable System went into service.




