
Dear Mr. Krech:

On June 26, 2015, Globe Telecom, Inc., GTI Corporation, Hawaiian Telcom Services Company, Inc., RAM Telecom International, Inc., TeleGuam Holdings, LLC d/b/a GTA TeleGuam (“GTA”), PT Telekomunikasi Indonesia International, and Telekomunikasi Indonesia International (USA) Inc.
