Dear Ms. Dortch,

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R § 1.1206(b), DOCOMO Pacific, Inc., provides information in response to requests made by International Bureau staff via email on March 29, 2016, with respect to the above-referenced application.

First, in response to the Bureau's query regarding the voting interest held by the Japanese Ministry of Finance holds in NTT DOCOMO, Inc. ("DOCOMO"), DOCOMO Pacific confirms that the Japanese Ministry of Finance holds a 35.21-percent voting interest in DOCOMO, the same percentage as its equity interest in DOCOMO.

Second, the Bureau requested clarification regarding the entities that will own and operate the cable landing stations on Saipan, Tinian, and Rota and whether these cable landing stations are planned or existing facilities. DOCOMO Pacific clarifies that:

- On Saipan, DOCOMO Pacific will enter into a long-term lease with the H.S. Lee Construction Company, Inc., for control of the existing H.S. Lee Building, which does not currently operate as a cable landing station.
- On Tinian, DOCOMO Pacific is in the process of acquiring the EMO Tower from the CNMI Government, which does not currently operate as a cable landing station.
- On Rota, DOCOMO Pacific will enter into a long-term lease with the CNMI Government for control of the existing Songsong Building, which does not currently operate as a cable landing station.


