Re: Telefónica International Wholesale Services USA, Inc., TI Wholesale Services Puerto Rico, Inc., and Telefónica International Wholesale Services América S.A. Application for a License to Land and Operate a Private Fiber-Optic Submarine Cable System Connecting Virginia, Puerto Rico, and Brazil, the BRUSA Cable System, File No. SCL-LIC-20160330-00011—Application Supplement and Amendment

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R § 1.1206(b), Telefónica International Wholesale Services USA, Inc. ("TIWS USA"), TI Wholesale Services Puerto Rico, Inc. ("TIWS Puerto Rico"), and Telefónica International Wholesale Services América S.A. ("TIWS América") (together, "Applicants"), provide information in response to requests made by International Bureau staff via email with respect to the above-referenced application and otherwise amend the application to reflect a recent corporate reorganization affecting the ownership, but not the control, of the Applicants.

First, in response to the Bureau's query regarding the voting interests held by Telefónica, S.A. in Telefónica International Wholesale Services, S.L. ("TIWS S.L"), Telefónica International Wholesale Services América S.A. ("TIWS América"), and Telefonica DataCorp S.A., the Applicants first clarify and amend their application to state that the ownership structure of the Applicants has changed since the Application has filed. As a consequence of related reorganization transactions:

- TIWS S.L. transferred its 26.86-percent voting-and-equity interest in TIWS América to Telxius Telecom, S.A.U. ("Telxius"), a Spanish *sociedad autonima unipersonal*, an existing wholly-owned, direct subsidiary of Telefónica S.A; and
- Telefónica, S.A. made a non-cash contribution to Telxius of the 73.14-percent voting-and-equity interest that it previously held in TIWS América.

As a consequence of these reorganization transactions, TIWS América is now a wholly-owned, direct subsidiary of Telxius and a wholly-owned, indirect subsidiary of Telefónica, S.A. These changes are shown graphically in a revised version of Appendix 5 of the above-referenced application, attached to this letter.

Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.767(a)(8)(i), 63.18(h), the Applicants certify respectively as follows:

- TIWS USA certifies that its only 10-percent-or-greater direct or indirect interest holders are TIWS América (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in TIWS USA), Telxius (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in TIWS América), and Telefónica, S.A. (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in Telxius).
- TIWS Puerto Rico certifies that its only 10-percent-or-greater direct or indirect interest
 holders are TIWS USA (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in TIWS
 Puerto Rico), TIWS América (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in
 TIWS USA), Telxius (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in TIWS
 América), and Telefónica, S.A. (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in
 Telxius).
- TIWS América certifies that its only 10-percent-or-greater direct or indirect interest holders are Telxius (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in TIWS América) and Telefónica, S.A. (which holds a 100-percent voting-and-equity interest in Telxius).
- Telxius is organized under the laws of Spain and maintains its principal place of business at Distrito C, Calle Ronda de la Comunicación s/n, Edificio Central, 28050. Its principal business is telecommunications.

Second, in response to the Bureau's request for confirmation, the Applicants state that other than the entities listed above and in part H of the application in response to 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.767(a)(7) and 63.18(h), no other person or entity holds a 10-percent-or-granter direct or indirect equity or voting interest in any Applicant.


