Re: Cable Landing License Applications for the Marea and BRUSA Submarine Cable Systems, FCC File Nos. SCL-LIC-20160525-00012 and SCL-LIC-20160330-00011

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the owners of the Marea and BRUSA submarine cable systems, I hereby update the U.S. cable landing station information submitted in the above-referenced files. These two systems will use the same cable landing station (“CLS”) at Virginia Beach, which will operate as a condominium with separate spaces for Marea and BRUSA dedicated system equipment and common spaces for shared facilities. The entire building will be managed and operated on a day-to-day basis by Telxius Cable USA, Inc. (“Telxius USA”), a joint applicant for each cable landing license.

For Marea, the applicants had stated on page 7, Table 2, of the cable landing license application filed on May 25, 2016, that control of the Virginia Beach CLS would be exercised by Microsoft Infrastructure, one of the joint applicants. Instead, Telxius USA will control the CLS on a day-to-day basis. The ownership shares of Edge Cable Holdings USA, LLC (“Edge USA”), Microsoft Infrastructure Group, LLC (“Microsoft Infrastructure”), and Telxius USA, as stated in Table 2 will remain unchanged. Within the Marea area of the CLS, Edge USA, Microsoft Infrastructure, and Telxius USA will each control separate private spaces for their own equipment, and will share common space for Marea shared facilities.

For BRUSA, the applicants had stated on page 8 of the cable landing license application filed on March 30, 2016, that the Virginia Beach CLS would be wholly owned by Telxius USA. Instead, Telxius Cable USA will own and control the BRUSA private space within the CLS condominium, and share some common facilities and space with the Marea system. Telxius USA will also continue to control the CLS on a day-to-day basis.
