Hawaiki Submarine Cable USA LLC ("HSC USA") hereby updates its submarine cable license application ("Application") for the Hawaiki Cable System ("Hawaiki") to reflect a new address for HSC USA. ${ }^{1}$ Specifically, HSC USA revises Appendix A, Information Required by 47 C.F.R. § 1.767(a)(1), to read as follows:

In addition, in its Application, HSC USA provided that the main trunk of the will be $100 \%$ owned and constructed by Hawaiki Submarine Cable Limited Partnership ("HSC LP"), a New Zealand limited partnership, and that all of the capacity on the main trunk will be owned by "HCP LP" and its affiliates. ${ }^{2}$ The reference to "HCP LP" was in error and should be replaced with "HSC LP." Pursuant to staff's request, HSC USA further clarifies that all capacity in the U.S., including U.S.

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territorial waters, will be owned and controlled by HSC USA. Hawaiki capacity in international waters and foreign countries will be owned by HSC LP or its affiliates.
