Dear Ms. Dortch:

Through their counsel, Pacific Carriage Limited Inc. and Southern Cross Cables Limited (together, “Applicants”) supplement the above-referenced application to land and operate the Southern Cross NEXT system (the “Application”) in order to address clarifications requested by Commission staff, as follows:

First, Applicants confirm that the 30.49-percent interest of Optus Networks Pty Limited in Pacific Cable Holdings Limited Inc. and the 30.49-percent interest of SingTel EInvestments Pte Ltd in Southern Cross Cables Holdings Limited are voting and economic interests (as stated in Appendices J and N).

Second, Applicants clarify that the statement in Appendix K that reads “Spark holds a 100-percent voting and economic interest in TSCL” should read “Spark holds a 100-percent voting and economic interest in TCNZ (Bermuda).”


