

On November 9, 2000, Atlantica USA, LCC, by its attorneys, provided specific descriptions of the geographic locations of the cable landing stations of the Atlantica-1 Network in (i) Tuckertown, New Jersey; (ii) Boca Raton, Florida; (iii) Maiquetia, Venezuela; (iv) Fortaleza, Brazil; (v) Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; and (vi) St. David's, Bermuda. The notification appeared on public notice on November 17, 2000. To supplement that notification, Atlantica USA, LLC, by its attorneys, now provides information concerning the coordinates of the landing points of the Atlantica-1 Network.
