On behalf of VSNL America, Inc. ("VSNL America") and VSNL Telecommunications (US) Inc. ("VSNL US"), this letter reports to the Commission that the Agreement among VSNL America, VSNL US, and Videsh Sanchar Nigam Limited ("VSNL"), the U.S. Department of Justice ("DoJ"), including the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI"), the U.S. Department of Homeland Security ("DHS"), and the U.S. Department of Defense ("DoD"), dated April 7, 2005 (the "Second NSA"), has been revised by an amendment dated December 12, 2005 (the "Amendment").

Background. On August 26, 2004, the Chief of the International Bureau released an Order, Authorization and Certificate granting with conditions the Section 214 application filed by VSNL America in File No. ITC-214-20030728-00376. The Section 214 authorization was made subject to compliance with the national security agreement signed by VSNL America, VSNL, the FBI, DoJ, and DHS (the "First NSA"). Section 8.6 of the First NSA provided that "[a]ny substantial modification of this Agreement shall be reported to the FCC within thirty (30) days after approval in writing by the Parties." On April 7, 2005, VSNL America, VSNL, the FBI, DoJ, DHS and DoD, entered into a second national security agreement (the "Second NSA"). Section 8.6 of the Second NSA provides that the agreement supersedes the First NSA, and that "[a]ny substantial modification to this Agreement shall be reported to the FCC within thirty (30) days after approval in writing by the Parties." The parties to the Second NSA jointly

submitted the Second NSA to the Commission on April 11, 2005 in File Nos. SCL-ASG-20050304-00003 and SCL-T/C-20050304-00005 (the "Teleglobe applications"). On December 12, 2005, the Second NSA parties entered into an agreement that amended the Second NSA (the "Amendment"). The Amendment was submitted to the Commission on December 13, 2005 in File Nos. ITC-T/C-20051213-00503 and SCL-T/C-20051213-00030. As referenced in Exhibit C to the Amendment, VSNL American and VSNL US accept that the grant of the Teleglobe applications be conditioned on compliance with the Second NSA, as amended. A copy of the Amendment is attached.

While VSNL America and VSNL US believe that the December 13, 2005 filing fulfills the reporting requirement in Section 8.6 of the Second NSA, this letter is submitted to ensure that the record in the above referenced proceeding reflects that a timely report was made to the Commission. VSNL America and VSNL US hereby request that the NSA compliance condition in the authorizations in the above-referenced proceedings, be modified to refer to the Second NSA, as amended.
