REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

Waybill Management Group, LLC (“Waybill” or the “Transferor”) (FRN: 0018511329) and Blue Ivory, LLC (“Blue Ivory” or the “Transferee”) (FRN: 0018468710) (together, the “Applicants”), through the undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 63.25 of the Commission’s Rules,¹ hereby request Special Temporary Authority (or “STA”) for the transfer of control of cable landing license holder Paniolo Cable Company, LLC (the “Licensee” or “Paniolo”) (FRN: 0016137721),² from Waybill to Blue Ivory. The Applicants request Special Temporary Authority until such time as their application for authority to transfer control of the Licensee, filed concurrently herewith, is granted by the Commission.

Background and Request for STA

As detailed in the underlying application for approval of the transfer of control of Paniolo, filed concurrently herewith and attached hereto as Exhibit A (the “Application”), on March 31, 2008, Waybill assigned its 96% membership interest in Paniolo to Blue Ivory. Prior to the assignment, Blue Ivory held a 4% membership interest in Paniolo. As a result of the assignment of Waybill’s membership interest, Blue Ivory acquired (direct) control of Paniolo (the “Transfer of Control”).

The sole managing member of Blue Ivory is Blue Ivory Hawaii Corp. The ownership interests in Blue Ivory Hawaii Corp. are held in equal share by three private trusts.³ The trustee of each of the Trusts is Janeen-Ann A. Olds, a U.S. citizen.⁴ Upon the assignment of Waybill’s membership interest in the Licensee to Blue Ivory, ultimate control of the cable landing license held by the Licensee was transferred to Ms. Olds as trustee of the Trusts.

The assignment of Waybill’s membership interest in the Licensee came about through and was interrelated with the larger financial transaction by which the parties secured funding for construction of the submarine cable system. Now that the significant time pressures and restrictive conditions associated with each funding phase have been resolved, the parties are able to seek approval from the Commission.

Public Interest Considerations


Grant of the requested Special Temporary Authority is in the public interest because it will enable the Licensee to continue its construction of the PFOC system without interruption and thereby remain on schedule to complete construction of the system in the 3rd quarter of 2009. As noted in the underlying application, the Transfer of Control did not result in any change to the architecture or capacity of the PFOC, which information is a matter of public record. The Transfer of Control, moreover, does not necessitate any change in the regulatory classification of the PFOC system. The Licensee will operate the PFOC on a non-common carrier basis and lease the PFOC solely to Sandwich Isles Communications, Inc. Furthermore, the Transfer of Control raises no competitive concerns because Blue Ivory is not, and is not affiliated with, a foreign carrier, and the PFOC, being a wholly intra-Hawaiian island system, has no landing point in any foreign country. Grant of the requested STA, therefore, will serve the public interest and is consistent with the Cable Landing License Act.

The Applicants acknowledge that the grant of this STA will not prejudice any action the Commission may take on the underlying application, File No. SCL-T/C-20090225-00003. The Applicants further acknowledge that this STA can be revoked by the Commission upon its own motion without a hearing, and that grant of an STA and the underlying application will not preclude enforcement action.

Conclusion

For the reasons discussed herein, the Applicants respectfully request that the Commission grant expeditiously this request for Special Temporary Authority for the transfer of control of the Licensee from Waybill to Blue Ivory.

APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER OF CONTROL

I. INTRODUCTION

Waybill Management Group, LLC (“Transferor” or “Waybill”) and Blue Ivory, LLC (“Transferee” or “Blue Ivory”) (together, the “Applicants”), through the undersigned counsel and pursuant to the Cable Landing License Act¹ and Section 1.767 of the Commission’s Rules,² hereby request authority to transfer control of the cable landing license held by Paniolo Cable Company, LLC (the “Licensee” or “Paniolo”) (FRN: 0016137721)³ from Waybill to Blue Ivory.

A. Summary of the Transaction

On March 31, 2008, Waybill assigned its 96% membership interest in the Licensee to Blue Ivory, a Wyoming limited liability company. Prior to the assignment, Blue Ivory held a 4% membership interest in the Licensee. As a result of the assignment of Waybill's membership interest, Blue Ivory acquired control of the Licensee (the "Transfer of Control").⁴

The sole managing member of Blue Ivory is Blue Ivory Hawaii Corp., a Hawaiian corporation. The ownership interests in Blue Ivory Hawaii Corp. are held in equal share by three private trusts: (i) the Adrienne H.R. Hee Irrevocable Trust, (ii) the Breanne E. R. Hee Irrevocable Trust and (iii) the Charlton E.R. Hee Irrevocable Trust (each, a "Trust," and collectively, the "Trusts"). Each Trust holds the shares of Blue Ivory Hawaii Corp. for the benefit of the named beneficiary.⁵ The trustee of each of the Trusts is Janeen-Ann A. Olds, a U.S. citizen.⁶ Ultimate control of the cable landing license held by the Licensee is therefore held by Ms. Olds, as trustee of the Trusts.

B. Request for Streamlined Processing of this Application

Pursuant to Section 1.767(j) of the Commission's rules,⁷ the Applicants request streamlined processing of this Application. Each Applicant certifies that it is not, and is not affiliated with, a foreign carrier, including an entity that owns or controls a foreign cable landing






