

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Through its counsel, Edge Cable Holdings USA, LLC (“Edge USA”) notifies the Commission that the above-referenced request to extend special temporary authority (“STA”) filed by the CAP-1 license applicants (which seeks authority to construct, connect, and test at their own risk those portions of the CAP-1 cable system in U.S. territory prior to the Commission’s grant of the Applicants’ pending cable landing license application) no longer seeks any authority for China Mobile International Limited (“CMI”). As explained the amended and restated cable landing license application filed concurrently with this letter, CMI is no longer participating in the construction, ownership, and operation of the CAP-1 system, which will now be constructed, owned, and operated by Edge USA and its affiliates and Amazon Data Services, Inc (“ADSI”). The amended and restated license application removes CMI as an applicant, and this notification does the same with respect to the STA request.
