Dear Mr. May:

On November 11, 2016, Murosa Development S.a.r.l. ("Murosa"), Hibernia Atlantic U.S. LLC ("HB Atlantic"), and GTT Communications, Inc. ("GTT") (collectively, the "Applicants") filed an application for consent to transfer control of HB Atlantic to GTT. The Applicants have entered into an agreement pursuant to which GTT will acquire all of the issued and outstanding shares, and therefore the control, of Hibernia NGS Limited ("HB NGS"), HB Atlantic's parent, and each of HB NGS' subsidiaries. HB NGS is the direct parent and sole member of HB Atlantic. Therefore, this transaction will result in a transfer of control of HB Atlantic, holder of the submarine cable landing license for the Hibernia Atlantic Cable System, SCL-LIC-19990804-00012, SCL-MOD-20020412-00022.

The above-referenced application has been filed pursuant to the provisions of the Cable Landing License Act, 47 U.S.C. §§ 34-39, section 1.767 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.767, and Executive Order No. 10530, § 5(a) (May 10, 1954), reprinted as amended in 3 U.S.C. § 301. The Counsel for the applicants has certified that on November 10, 2016, they have served copies of the application to the Department of State, NTIA, and DISA as required by the Commission's rules 47 CFR § 1.767 (j).

This letter begins the 30-day review process set out in the letter from the Under Secretary of State for Economic, Business, and Agricultural Affairs to the Chairman, Federal Communications Commission (dated Dec. 3, 2001).
