
Dear Ms. Dortch:

By this letter, the undersigned clarify that the *pro forma* transfer of control filed with the Commission on January 30, 2020, in the above-referenced file involved only AST Telecom, LLC (“AST”) and did not affect the direct or indirect ownership of the other two joint licensees, American Samoa Hawaii Cable, LLC (“ASHC”) and Samoa American Samoa Cable, LLC (“SASC”).

- Amalgamated Telecom Holdings Limited (“ATH Parent”) owns a 100-percent voting and equity interest in Amalgamated Bluesky Telecom Holdings LLC (“ABTH LLC”).
- Prior to December 31, 2019, ABTH LLC existed as Amalgamated Bluesky Telecom Holdings Incorporated (“ABTHI”). ABTHI was converted from a corporation to a limited liability company on that date.
- ABTH LLC holds a 100-percent voting and equity interest in AST.
- ATH Parent holds 100-percent voting and equity interest in eLandia Technologies, Inc. (“ELT”).
- ELT holds a 66.67-percent voting and equity interest in ASHC.
- ASHC holds a 100-percent voting and equity interest in SASC.

Mr. Fong’s certification should have been omitted from the January 30, 2020 notification.
