T-Mobile USA hereby requests Commission approval of the *pro forma* transfer of control of the submarine cable landing licenses held by SCCLP, which will result from the conversion of Sprint Communications, Inc. and Sprint Corporation into limited liability companies (called Sprint Communications LLC and Sprint LLC, respectively). The transaction is scheduled to take place on December 31, 2021. Attached are charts showing the ownership of the licensee before and after the transaction.³

Because the LLC conversions described above do not change the ultimate control of any affected wireless license (all remain controlled by T-Mobile USA), the transaction is *pro forma* in nature.⁴ The Commission has stated that, in situations "where no substantial change of control will result from the transfer or assignment, grant of the application is deemed presumptively in


³ The transferee is a direct wholly owned subsidiary of T-Mobile US, Inc. ("T-Mobile US"), a U.S.organized entity, which is indirectly controlled by Deutsche Telekom AG ("DT"), a publicly traded German corporation. DT has *de facto* control of T-Mobile US – and thus T-Mobile USA – as a result of a proxy agreement which authorizes DT to vote a majority of the stock of T-Mobile US. 
