This letter provides notice on behalf of Row 44, Inc. ("Row 44"), pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the FCC's Rules, that on February 26, 2009, the undersigned counsel had a telephone conversation with Rod Porter, Deputy Bureau Chief of the International Bureau, concerning the above-referenced applications. In addition to inquiring about the status of the pending request for special temporary authority ("STA")(FCC File No. SES-STA-20080711-00928), counsel noted that each day that passes without approval of the proposed STA testing operation is a day lost for gathering data in cooperation with the satellite operators that have agreed to assist Row 44 in its in-flight testing of its aeronautical remote terminals. Such data is then to be made available to the International Bureau as it considers final action on the license application.
