Dear Ms. Dortch:

Gogo LLC ("Gogo"), by its attorney and pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, hereby updates the record regarding Gogo's above-referenced amendment (the "Gogo Amendment") to its pending modification application.<sup>1</sup> Specifically, Gogo withdraws the request in the Gogo Amendment for authority to use SES-6 capacity in the 11.2-11.45 GHz band.

The Gogo Modification sought to add SES-6 and several other satellites to Gogo's license for earth stations aboard aircraft ("ESAAs"). Gogo indicated in the modification that downlink communications between SES-6 and the ESAA terminals would use the 10.95-11.2 GHz band.<sup>2</sup> In the amendment, Gogo sought authority for additional SES-6 downlink spectrum in the 11.2-11.45 GHz band.<sup>3</sup> In fact, however, Gogo does not propose to use the 11.2-11.45 GHz band for communications with its ESAA terminals. Instead, that band is planned for use only on downlinks from SES-6 to the associated teleport in Europe. Accordingly, Gogo hereby withdraws its request for authority to use SES-6 capacity in the 11.2-11.45 GHz band for ESAA operations.
