DOCUMENTATION OF EXEMPTION
FROM FAA NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

The facility proposed in the attached application is a cluster of satellite antennas, with the largest satellite antennas in this cluster are 4.2 meter satellite downlink antennas mounted on a 3.6 meter pole, that are located on the roof of a 13.1 meter tall building. With these antennas in operation with any of the domestic arc, permitted list satellites, the maximum operational height will never exceed 5.7 meters above the roof of the existing building. Thus, pursuant to Section 17.14(b) of the FCC Rules and Section 77.15(b) of the FAA Rules and Regulations, this downlink facility is totally exempted from FAA notification requirements, since its height above the roof of an existing building will never exceed 6.1 meters.
